Updated May 5, 2020

Dear Public and Funeral Homes:

Governor Abbot clarified in his speech Tuesday, May 4, 2020 and also the county judge and the county attorney recommend following the guidelines as listed in AG Guidance for Houses of Worship During the COVID-19 Crisis and the Texas Open Report. Those guidelines are available at www.clevelandtexas.com under City Services – Cemetery.

Our City facilities have been closed to the public effective March 18, 2020, if you have a family that needs to buy a funeral plot we can assist them over the phone or by email. If they need to buy a plot with a check or cash that can be conducted through the water department drive-thru at City Hall. If they are paying by credit card, we can do that over the phone and email them receipt or mail to their home address.

If they need to see the plots prior to purchasing them, an appointment will need to be made via a phone call or email with my office at City Hall to schedule the appointment with the cemetery staff to meet with the family. We will ask if a family member has a fever or is ill, if so, all contact will have to be done by phone to protect our city staff.

These measures are being placed to be proactive with the social distancing and to help stop the spread of the virus.

Please do not send any families over to our offices without an appointment so it will not increase stress on the families during their sorrowful time.

We are here to assist you it just will be less in person than before.

Thank you for your help with these new and changing times. When updates occur as it relates to funeral services we will update this letter.
