

City Council met for a Special Called City Council meeting and Election Canvass on June 28, 2022, in person at 907 E. Houston, Cleveland, Texas, with Mayor Richard Boyett presiding.

Invocation, Pledge, and Roll Call

Mayor Richard Boyett called the Special Called City Council meeting to order at 6:00 pm and did a roll call of council, which showed that there was a quorum. Police Chief Darrel Broussard gave the Invocation and everyone recited the pledge to the US and Texas flag.

Elections

Councilmember Terrell made a motion to approve with a second from Councilmember Lowery. All members present voted "AYE". Motion carried.

8. Discuss and take action concerning the recording of City of Cleveland executive meetings as provided and allowed by State of Texas law

Councilmember Clay made a motion to revert back to doing the certified agendas with a second from Councilmember Lowery. All members present voted "AYE". Motion carried.

11. Consideration and possible action by city council to appoint an interim city manager


Councilmember Lowery made a motion to appoint Robert Reynolds as Interim City Manager until a new City Manager is chosen, with no additional compensation.
