Short Term Commercial Permit to Operate Aerial Applicators at The Cleveland Municipal Airport

II. Permit Conditions:

The Operator agrees to the following conditions as a requirement for granting, and the continuance, of this Permit to conduct the above described aerial application operations from the airport.

- A. Operations conducted under this Permit shall be done in compliance with Federal, State, and Local laws, ordinances and regulations
- B. Operator shall provide the City of Cleveland or its designated representative written proof of current insurance.

- C. Operator agrees to reimburse the City of Cleveland for any Damage to the airport facilities and improvements beyond normal wear and tear that may be caused by "NORMAL" use.
- D. The operator shall maintain the airport area free of trash, oil, fuel product spills. Any trash, litter, or spill shall be cleaned by the operator, at the operators expense as soon as safety permits.
- E. THE OPERATOR AGREES TO FOLLOW STANDARD GROUND AND AIR TRAFFIC PROCEDURES IN EFFECT AT THE CLEVELAND MUNICIPAL AIRPORT.**
- F. The terms and conditions described under which this permit is issued will prevail at all times and changes in the business character, activity, or ownership will invalidate this permit.
- G. The Owner reserves the unlimited right to terminate this permit and stop operations which it deems a "HAZARD TO THE PUBLIC OR OTHER AIRCRAFT."

III. Permit Fee:

- A. Operator agrees to compensate THE CITY OF CLEVELAND as a condition of this permit.
 - 1. Operation dispensing less than 20,000 pounds of product (one eighteen wheeler's trailer or less)..... \$ 20.00
 - 2. Operation dispensing more than 20,000 pounds but less than 100,000 pounds of product. (less than four eighteen wheeler trailers)..... \$ 60.00
 - 3. Operations dispensing more than 100,000 pounds of product (more than four eighteen wheeler trailers)..... \$120.00
 - 4. Operations larger than listed above..... \$200.00

Note: Helicopters will be included in the above fee schedule. It is not the air vehicles that do damage to the facility but rather the vehicles used to deliver the aerial applicator the product to be dispensed. Fees are based on the number and size of the vehicles used to accomplish the applicators need.

IV. Location of Operation:

- A. Commercial ground operations may only be conducted in the area designated by the Airport Owner or a representative designated by the City.
